How do I request my file?

Pursuant to Louisiana Public Access law La.R.S. 44:1, et seq, all Road Home applicants may request a copy of their Road Home file. Requests should include the applicant's Road Home application identification number, the address of the damaged property and a current mailing address. All requests must be signed and dated by the applicant.

If an applicant is represented by an Advocate and the Advocate is requesting the file, they must provide The Road Home Advocate request form signed and dated by the applicant.

In accordance with Louisiana law, applicable fees will be assessed. Fees will be waived, however, for Road Home applicants requesting documents included in their individual file.
